



Works commenced on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> April to upgrade the A523 Adlington crossroads with all works originally planned to be completed late-August 2022, including the reopening of Mill Lane at its junction with the A523 London Road.

The works include the widening of the existing carriageway and upgrading the traffic light signals. Works are currently in progress to complete the south west side of the junction, following diversions of electricity and communication services.

## **Extension to Mill Lane Closure**

Due to unforeseen circumstances beyond our control we need to divert a medium pressure gas main, which is necessary to complete the works on the north west side of the junction. It is anticipated this will commence in September with construction works to complete the junction upgrade to follow immediately after.

The unforeseen diversion has impacted the works programme and now means Mill Lane will remain closed at its junction with the A523 London Road until **December 2022**.

Temporary traffic lights will remain in place on the A523 London Road to manage traffic throughout the period of the works.
